2010 INTER CLUB COMPETITIONS ENTRY INFORMATION

Thank you once again for organising and delivering cricketing opportunities for junior players in 2009.

This is the official 'all in one' entry paperwork which must be returned to the 'Receiving and Clearing House' by the designated due date to ensure that your club is entered into the competitions you have requested for the forthcoming 2010 cricketing season.

NB: If your entry form is not received by the Clearing House Manager by the due date you will not be able to enter the available competitions.

Please find all relevant details pertaining to entry listed as follows:

Affiliation

All clubs entering junior competitions organised through the Worcestershire Cricket Board umbrella are required to pay an affiliation fee. Affiliation fees are now collected directly by the Worcestershire Cricket Board (or the Worcestershire Cricket League for clubs within its structure) and information will be forwarded to your club secretary separately in due course.

NB: Please do not address any questions concerning affiliation packages and fees to the Clearing House Manager. Club Affiliation fees should not be forwarded with your club entry forms. All affiliation fees will be collected centrally as stated above.

2010 Competition Fees

Each competition will be £10.00 to enter, i.e. if you are entering the under 13 cup and league the fee will be £20.00.

If two or more teams are entered in any individual competition then a 50% reduction will apply to the additional teams entered. i.e. if 2 teams are entered into the Under 12's League the fee will be £15.

NB: Please note that only 1 team per club can be entered into knock out cup competitions

Girls Competitions

All Girls competition entries will be processed through the clearing house. Please see the competition descriptor sheet and the section on the overall entry form. You must return the entry form and relevant paperwork to the clearing house even if you only wish to enter girl's competitions.

NB: Please do not forward the paperwork to any other contact than the Clearing House Manager.

Entry Form and Contact Details

You will no longer be required to input address details for each age group manager on the entry form. The only required information for managers will be telephone numbers and E-Mail Addresses.

However please note that functioning e-mail addresses are vitally important as the majority of communications during the season will be made using this method.

NB: Please provide the most up to date contact details for your overall Club Junior Manager & Club Girls Coordinator. See Inter Club Competition Entry Form.

Boys Fixtures

Outline fixture timelines will be forwarded to the identified Club Junior Managers. Finalised fixtures can be confirmed at fixtures meetings which will be communicated to all in due course. **Please note that in 2010 there will be a County-Wide Pilot Premier Division for U11s and U12s; details can be found on the competition descriptor.**

Girls Fixtures

Winter Indoor competition details will be forwarded directly to the identified Club Girls Coordinator. Outline fixture timelines for spring/summer outdoor competitions/leagues will also be forwarded to the identified Girls Coordinator. All fixtures can be organised at the Girls fixtures meeting which will be communicated to all in due course.

WCB Website

Competition rules and regulations are to be revised and will be available on the WCB website. These should be downloaded and printed for each manager as they may contain minor revisions to the ECB and WCB rules from previous years.

Under 16 Cricket

Please direct all your enquiries concerning Under 16 cricket to the relevant regional organisers. Under 16 cricket is run independently to the Worcestershire Cricket Board by the Lords Taverners.

Returns & Payment

Please do not delay returning your entry form if you do not know your 2010 age group managers details (these can be forwarded at a later date). If you can complete the managers details at this point this will help the league organisers prepare the competition paperwork for each age group. However at this point, as a minimum, we need your Club Junior Manager and Club Girls Coordinator contact details and the competitions you wish to enter.
