**Re: Worcestershire Cricket Board - Talented Player Nominations - 2010 Season**

The Worcestershire Cricket Board wish to select County and District age group squads for boys for the 2010 cricketing season. Practice and match playing programmes for **County squads** are currently being planned for boys at under 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17.

In addition, in 2010 we are planning to deliver supporting under 11, 12 & 13 **District** Cricketing programmes and competitions for boys.

I enclose a 'Talented Player Nomination Form' and invite you to nominate suitably talented boys for assessment. Please note that a nomination fee of £5 is required for each nomination and should be included with each form. Should you wish to nominate more than one young cricketer, would you please photocopy the form and return one complete form for each young player.

A player shall be eligible to play representative cricket provided at least one of the following applies:-

- He was born within the county/district boundary, or
- He resides within the county/district boundary, or
- He attends an educational establishment within the county/district boundary, or
- He is a bona fide playing member of a club within the county/district boundary for at least the entire preceding season.

Please provide as much information on your nomination as possible and ensure all forms are returned to the address provided at the foot of the nomination form by **Friday 2nd October 2009**.

Once in receipt of your nomination/s all following correspondence regarding the relevant District/County assessment will be communicated directly between the Cricket Board and the individual.
